

WHAT IS PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION?

INTRODUCTION

Parent's teacher association (PTA) is a formal organization of parents and teachers that is formed to get parents involved in their children's academics as well as to help and reform the school systems. The main focus of any PTA is to work for the prosperity of the school going children. PTAs provide parents and teachers a mutual platform to work for the betterment of the school, teaching and everything that influences the physical and intellectual growth of a child. PTA meeting helps both parents and teachers to involve and discuss and solve any particular issues they are facing.

NEED OF PTA

- Involves parents in identifying areas for improvement, offering valuable perspectives.
- Enhances home-school communication through effective two-way interaction between parents and teachers.
- Facilitates fundraising efforts to provide students with additional resources and facilities.
- Strengthens relationships between parents and teachers, fostering a better understanding of students' home environments.
- Provides a platform to discuss and address the academic performance of individual students.
- Serves as a channel for parents to propose and advocate for meaningful changes at their child's school.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- Foster a strong connection between the child's home and school.
- Promote the well-being and holistic development of children and youth in their homes, schools, and communities.
- Enhance the quality of family life to better support the child's growth.
- Advocate for policies and regulations ensuring the care, protection, and rights of children and youth.

- Provide meaningful support for school events and other significant occasions.

ROLE OF TEACHER

A parent-teacher association (PTA) can only be effective with full cooperation from both parents and teachers. The roles of teachers in a PTA include:

- Regularly update parents about school activities, programs, and events.
- Communicate students' examination results to parents promptly.
- Inform parents about any funds collected for school purposes and their intended use.
- Engage with parents to discuss students' progress and collaboratively address any challenges.
- Reach out to parents if a student is absent for an extended period to understand and address the reason.
- Notify parents if homework or project work is consistently incomplete.
- Keep parents informed about excursions, trips, or any other school-related activities requiring their awareness or consent.

ROLE OF PARENTS

Before starting school, a child receives their foundational education at home, guided primarily by their parents. Parents play a vital role in the holistic development of their child. Their responsibilities include:

- Monitor their children's activities regularly and provide guidance at home.
- Actively participate in PTA meetings and contribute to discussions.
- Motivate children to participate in various school activities to enhance their learning experience.
- Collect examination results on time and consult teachers about academic progress.
- Observe and encourage the child's interest in education and school activities.
- Maintain regular communication with teachers to stay informed about school updates and the child's performance.




MEMBERS OF PARENTS TEACHER ASSOCIATION (2025-2026)
